

Medicines Prompt Chart



Prompting – ‘the action of saying something to persuade, encourage or remind someone to do or say something’. Prompting the person to take their medicines is reminding a person of the time and asking if they have or are going to take their medicines. The person still has the responsibility to take their medicines. The person will still take the medicines themselves e.g. remove from the packaging but requires a reminder or a check to see if they have remembered to take their medicines.
