February to May 2020 saw the highest access to materials in the last 6 months with a total **2,836** materials accessed

February—April had the lowest training log on's (down a third) probably due to covid workload

May was the highest month for people accessing news items, resources and discussion boards

New log on registrations up **33%**
New providers joining up **22%**

Care home access to Scils dropped by 60% and Homecare access rose by 22% during covid pressure months

KCC Homecare services access to Scils rose by 490% during the last 6 months
